SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS

Background

In order to assist in the efficient operation of the Division and the optimal utilization of school facilities, school attendance boundaries may be established.

Procedures

- 1. Where school attendance boundaries have been established, a student will be required to attend the school designated for that area.
- 2. In individual cases where it appears to be in the interests of the student or the school or both, the Superintendent may approve a student's transfer to another school.
- 3. A principal may admit a student designated to another school attendance area.
- 4. When a student is admitted into a school outside of his/her designated attendance area, the parents will be responsible for transportation at their own expense.
