CHALLENGED LEARNING RESOURCES

Background

The Division shall provide a process whereby concerned individuals or groups may register a complaint regarding any items included in the learning commons (library) collection or used as a learning resource by a staff member or consultant. The following procedure is provided to facilitate this process.

Procedures

- 1. The complaint is to be received courteously and non-judgmentally by the individual who is contacted.
- 2. The complainant shall be asked to complete the Request for Reconsideration of Learning Resources Form (Form 207-1).
- 3. The Principal is to be advised immediately of the nature of the complaint.
- 4. Copies of the completed Form 207-1 shall be distributed to:
 - 4.1. The Principal;
 - 4.2. The Superintendent; and
 - 4.3. The Review Committee.
- 5. The Principal, in consultation with the Superintendent, shall establish a Review Committee to examine the item(s) in question and make recommendations.
- 6. Materials in question shall be evaluated with respect to:
 - 6.1. Administrative Procedure 270 Learning Commons and Selection of Learning Materials
 - 6.2. Alberta Education policy re: Controversial Issues in the Classroom; and
 - 6.3. Existing community culture and values.
- 7. The recommendations of the Review Committee shall be provided to the Principal for consideration in a decision.
- 8. The Principal shall advise the complainant notified in writing of the decision.
- 9. The Principal's decision may be appealed to the Superintendent.
