USE OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES IN SCHOOLS

Background

The use of electronic devices can interfere with an individual's right to privacy, the student's right to a safe and caring environment and the teaching and learning process; therefore, the Superintendent requires principals, in consultation with appropriate stakeholders, to formulate and implement appropriate procedures at the school site.

Procedures

- 1. The school procedures must take into consideration the student population at the school.
- 2. The procedures must have clear expectations regarding appropriate personal and educational use of electronic devices.
- 3. The procedures must be published appropriately so that all stakeholders are aware.
- 4. All students and staff must read and sign the division technology user agreement.
