TEACHER TRANSITION TO RETIREMENT

Background

In order to facilitate an employee's transition to retirement, the Division will endeavour to employ successful applicants on a temporary contract for the remainder of the school year in which the teacher retires.

Procedures

- 1. The Transition to Retirement Program is a Division-sponsored plan developed to assist teachers with the transition to retirement.
- 2. Approval of a teacher's request to participate in the plan is the responsibility of the Superintendent or designate in consultation with the teacher's school administration.
- 3. In order to participate in the Transition to Retirement Program teachers and administrators shall retire from the Division upon being accepted into the program. Teachers or administrators will be offered a temporary contract for the remainder of the school year in which the teacher retires.
- 4. Applications must be received by the Superintendent or designate prior to November 30th, for teachers retiring December 31st, and prior to December 20th for teachers retiring January 31st.
- 5. It is the responsibility of the teacher to communicate directly with ATRF (Alberta Teachers' Retirement Fund) to ensure any offered temporary contract timeline does not affect pension disbursements.
