Nomination period open for 2021 General Election

Leduc — The nomination period for the 2021 General Election is currently open. Residents with a passion for Catholic education and a willingness to serve their community are invited to run for a position on STAR Catholic School Division's Board of Trustees.

What is a School Trustee?

School Board Trustees are elected by and held accountable to their community for a four-year term. Trustees set goals and priorities for the Division while considering community needs and upholding sound educational practice. Boards make decisions with the best interests of students, staff, and families at top of mind. Trustees engage with communities on behalf of the Division, create policy and adopt budgets, and lobby all levels of government to ensure the voices of the Division and community are heard. Trustees are role models who maintain a positive public image on behalf of the Division.

Who Can Be a School Trustee?

Candidates must be 18 years or older, a Canadian citizen, and must live in their ward on Election Day and for the six months before Nomination Day. Candidates must be Catholic and may not be employees of STAR Catholic School Division. Interested individuals must be committed and willing to work to uphold a high standard of quality Catholic education in the communities they serve.

How Do I Submit My Nomination?

Interested candidates can visit STAR Catholic School Division's <u>website</u> for authorization forms, nomination papers, and a candidate package. Hard copies of nomination forms may also be picked up at the Division's Central Office located at 4906 50th Ave, Leduc. Completed nomination forms must be dropped off by appointment only. Please call 780.986.2500 to arrange an appointment.

Election Day is October 18, 2021. Candidates may submit their nomination papers until September 20, 2021.
